All-Star Volleyball Reporting Instructions pg. 2 June 19, 2024

Insurance: The MAC provides secondary accidental medical insurance. Your parents have already signed a form indicating they understand this procedure.

What to Bring:

1. All practice apparel--shorts, socks and shoes for practice. Shorts should be athletic shorts – no cutoffs.
2. Casual shorts, slacks, and shirts.
3. Towels, sheets, pillow, and regular toiletry items used at home.
4. **Your school uniform.**

What NOT To Bring:

Players cannot wear earrings in practices or the games.

Meals:

Meals will be provided by the MAC.

Conduct:

All players will be under the supervision of the MAC and the All-Star Coaches. You have agreed to follow all the rules of the Mississippi Association of Coaches, and are expected to keep your word.

M.A.C. Board policy states that "should any All-Star Player violate any rule of conduct of the host college or the Association, that player will be sent home immediately."

Checking Out:

Before leaving Brandon High School after the game, be sure to have your post-participation physical screening by the **Mississippi Sports Medicine/Elite** trainers.
