Native of Moss point who played on back to back 5A Championship teams. Played defensive back at Ole Miss; Coaching experience includes Millsaps, Charleston Southern, and Fresno State

TERRELL BUCKLEY-MISS. STATE

Native of Pascagoula, recently hired as safeties coach at MSU; Defensive back at Florida State; 1st team All-American and received Jim Thorpe Award; Played 14 years in NFL at Green Bay, Miami, Denver, New England. Jets and Giants; Coaching stints include: Florida State, Akron, and Louisville State

DAN WERNER-OLE MISS

Co-Offensive coordinator/Quarterbacks coach at OM; 2016 Sugar Bowl winners; Three decades coaching experience including eight years in two terms at Univ. Miami; Has also coached at Cornell, Murray State, Auburn, and UNLV.
