REPORTING DATE/TIME:	Saturday, February 16, 2019, by 9:00 a.m. (please be on time)
<b>REPORT TO:</b>	Bulldog Stadium, Brandon High School, 3090 Highway 18, Brandon, MS
UNIFORMS:	Bring your school uniform; <u>North</u> All-Stars please bring <u>light</u> uniforms; <u>South</u> All-Stars please bring <u>dark</u> uniforms.
MEDICAL EXAM:	As you check in, you will be given a pre-game physical screening by the staff of Mississippi Sports Medicine & Orthopaedic Center.
INSURANCE:	<u>The M.A.C. provides secondary accidental medical insurance</u> . This has already been explained and your parents have signed a statement indicating they understand this.
PHOTO SESSION:	Girls-9:30; Boys-10:00. Each player will receive a copy of the team photo.
AWARDS:	Please complete the <u>Coca-Cola Student Athlete Award or William Winter</u> <u>Award form</u> and fax completed form to the MAC at 601-924-3050. (The Coca-Cola Award will be presented to a player in the Girls' Game, and The William Winter Award will be presented to a player in the Boys' Game).
TICKETS:	<i>Kickoff for the girls' game will be at 12:00 Noon. Kickoff for the boys' game will be at approximately 2:00 p.m.</i> General admission tickets (good for both games) will be available at the gate for \$5.00.
WHAT TO BRING:	<ol> <li>School Uniform, and white, long sleeve, cold gear to wear underneath uniform</li> <li>One (1) practice soccer ball</li> <li>Shin guards; ALL PLAYERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO WEAR SHIN GUARDS</li> <li>Cleats</li> </ol>
<u>NOTE</u> :	<u>Boys are not allowed to wear earrings at any time.</u> Girls cannot wear earrings in practice or game.
COMMISSIONS:	Players who sold a minimum of \$300 in ads will receive a commission check.
CHECKING OUT:	Before leaving the stadium, you must have a post-participation physical screening (provided by Mississippi Sports Medicine trainers)
