**Place to Report:** **Waddle Facility Complex, William Carey University, Hattiesburg, MS**

Diamond Club members will be there to assist you. Please be prepared to pay \$50 if you lose your room key.

**Medical Exam:** All players must have a medical exam by a qualified physician. A form for the physician to sign indicating you have satisfactorily passed your medical exam is on the following page.

**Be sure to bring this signed form with you when you report to WCU on June 6; you will not be allowed to practice or play without meeting this requirement!**  
(Your school physical copy will be accepted if it is still in effect for June 6-8.)

**What to Bring:** You will need sheets, towels, toilet items and practice equipment. **You must bring your high school uniform, and all other game equipment, including socks, caps, bats, gloves, etc., for the game. Catchers will also need their equipment.**

For practice you will need T-shirts, shorts or practice pants, and cleats. The T-shirts may not carry any logos advertising alcohol or cigarettes.
