SUBJECT: Final Instructions for All-Star Fast Pitch Softball Activities

These instructions should furnish all the information you need to help you follow through on your responsibilities.

Reporting Date: Thursday, May 30, 2019

Reporting Time: By 1:00 p.m. (Please be on time).

Report To: Wayne Hall (this is the dorm where you will be housed) at Jones County Junior College, 900 South Court Street, Ellisville, MS. Coaches and college host will be there to greet you.

Uniforms: **Please bring your high school uniform.**

Meeting: 2:00 p.m. in Wayne Hall lobby. Wear your uniform to this meeting.
Do not wear cleats in this building. Wear your regular shoes, and bring your cleats.

Photo Session: 3:00 p.m. (approximate) Thursday

Medical Exam: The medical examination will be given to you Thursday at approximately 5:30 p.m. The examinations will be administered by the staff of Hattiesburg Clinic. Your participation depends upon your passing this examination satisfactorily.

Games will be played on Friday and Saturday, May 30 – June 1 at Community Bank Park, Jones County Junior College. Friday's games will be as follows: the first 1A/2A/3A game will begin at 5:00 p.m.; after introduction of all the All-Star Players and their coaches at approximately 6:45 p.m., the first 4A/5A/6A game will begin at 7:00 p.m. Game 2 for 1A/2A/3A will begin at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, followed by Game 2 for 4A/5A/6A at 12:00 noon. General admission game tickets will be available at the gate for \$5.00 each (those purchasing tickets on Friday will be given wrist bands that will also allow entrance to Saturday's games).

Checking Out: At the conclusion of the All-Star games, you must have a post-participation physical before leaving the ball field.

Ad Commission: The All-Star Coaches will issue commission checks to the All-Star players who sold a minimum of \$350 in ads.

What To Bring:

1. Your High School Uniform
2. All practice apparel. (Laundry service will be provided for practice apparel each day.)
3. One (1) practice ball, your glove, and at least one bat. (Bats and gloves will not be furnished.)
4. Towels, sheets, pillow and personal care items.
5. Casual clothes.
6. **Be sure to bring your BAT and GLOVE and BATTING HELMET.**

Cars: If you bring a car, you will be required to leave it parked in the dorm parking lot at all times, and turn the keys in to your all-star coach.

Once you arrive, all transportation necessary will be provided by the M.A.C.

Special Note: All players will be under the supervision of the college host and the all-star coaches. You are expected to follow the rules of Jones County Junior College and the M.A.C.

Players are not permitted to wear earrings at practice or in the games.

M.A.C. Board policy states that "should any all-star player violate any rule of conduct of the host college or the Association, that player will be sent home immediately.
