Montgomery, AL 36104**

FOR GPS NAVIGATION – use Multiplex address – 220 Hall Street, Montgomery, AL 36104 (The Multiplex is adjacent to Cramton Bowl – see map of Cramton Bowl on back of this page.)

FROM AUBURN/OPELIKA – Take I-85 South and get off at the Union Street Exit (#1); turn right and stay on Union Street until you get to Madison Avenue; turn right and pass Cramton Bowl and turn right onto Hall Street; go pass the side of the stadium and turn right into the Multiplex parking lot; enter South entrance door of Multiplex.

FROM BIRMINGHAM – Take I-65 South and get off at the Clay Street/Herron Street Exit (#172); turn left onto Herron Street and go about 2 miles; pass Cramton Bowl and turn right onto Hall Street; go pass the side of the stadium and turn right into the Multiplex parking lot; enter South entrance door of Multiplex.

FROM MOBILE – Take I-65 North and get off at the Herron Street/Clay Street Exit (#172); turn right onto Herron Street and go about 2 miles; pass Cramton Bowl and turn right onto Hall Street; go pass the side of the stadium and turn right into the Multiplex parking lot; enter South entrance door of Multiplex.

FROM SELMA – Take U.S. 80 East and continue until you get to I-65; take I-65 North and get off at the Herron Street/Clay Street Exit (#172); turn right onto Herron Street and go about 2 miles; pass Cramton Bowl and turn right onto Hall Street; go pass the side of the stadium and turn right into the Multiplex parking lot; enter South entrance door of Multiplex.

FROM SYLACAUGA/ALEX CITY/ WETUMPKA – Take U.S. 231/AL 21 South (becomes Dickinson Drive/Federal Drive); turn right onto Madison Avenue; continue on Madison Avenue until you come to Hall Street and turn left; go pass the side of Cramton Bowl and turn right into the Multiplex parking lot; enter South entrance door of Multiplex.

FROM TROY – Take U.S. 231 North; turn right onto Southern Blvd.; continue on Southern Blvd. until you get to I-85; take I-85 South and get off at the Union Street Exit (#1); turn right and stay on Union Street until you get to Madison Avenue; turn right and pass Cramton Bowl and turn right onto Hall Street; go pass the side of the stadium and turn right into the Multiplex parking lot; enter South entrance door of Multiplex.
