SUBJECT: Instructions for All-Star Activities March 11-13, 2020

Please read the following instructions carefully; they should furnish all the information you need to help you follow through on your responsibilities.

What to Bring:

1. *Ticket sales money will be collected upon arrival.*
2. All practice apparel--shorts, socks and shoes for practice. Shorts should be athletic shorts -- no cutoffs.
3. Casual shorts, slacks and shirts.

What NOT To Bring: M.A.C. rules will not permit male players to wear earrings during any of the All-Star activities. Therefore we advise those of you who wear earrings to leave them at home. Failure to comply with this rule will result in dismissal from the team. Female players cannot wear earrings in practices or the game.

Cars: If you bring a car, you will be required to park it in the parking lot at all

times, and turn the keys in to your All-Star Coach. **Any travel necessary will be provided by the M.A.C.**

Conduct: All players will be under the supervision of the All-Star Coaches. You have agreed to follow all the rules of the Mississippi Association of Coaches, and are expected to keep your word.

M.A.C. Board policy states that "should any All-Star Player violate any rule of conduct of the Association, that player will be sent home immediately".

Insurance: The MAC provides secondary accidental medical insurance. Your parents have already signed a form indicating they understand this procedure.

Game Tickets: The games will be played Friday, March 13, at the A.E. Wood coliseum on the campus of Mississippi College in Clinton, MS. The girls' game will begin at 5:00 p.m.; the boys' game will follow at approximately 7:00 p.m. \$10.00 general admission tickets will be available at the door.

Mississippi College is located in Clinton on Hwy 80 between Springridge Rd (I-20 Exit 36) and Clinton-Raymond Rd (I-20 Exit 35)

Checking Out: Before leaving Mississippi College after the game, be sure to have your post-participation physical screening by the **Mississippi Sports Medicine** trainers. Players will be dismissed after the game to return home with their parents/guardians.
