Reporting Date: Saturday, July 18, 2020

Reporting Times: 1A/2A/3A Girls will report at 10:30 a.m.; Game will begin at 12 noon.
1A/2A/3A Boys will report at 1:00 p.m.; Game will begin at 2:30 p.m.
4A/5A/6A Girls will report at 3:30 p.m.; Game will begin at 5:00 p.m.
4A/5A/6A Boys will report at 6:00 p.m.; Game will begin at 7:30 p.m.

Important Note: Please do not report before your designated time.

Report To: A.E. Wood Coliseum, Mississippi College, Clinton, MS

Checking In/Out: Upon arrival, players will be issued a uniform and will change into uniforms in the restrooms (maximum of 5 players in restroom at one time). You will also be given a pre-participation physical screening by the Mississippi Sports Medicine trainers at this time. Before leaving Mississippi College after your game, you will turn in your uniform and have a post-participation physical screening. ***Commission checks for All-Stars who sold a minimum of \$350.00*** in ad sales will be issued upon check-out.

What to Bring: Game shoes and socks.

What NOT To Bring: M.A.C. rules will not permit players to wear earrings during All-Star activities; therefore, we advise those of you who wear earrings to leave them at home.

Conduct: All players will be under the supervision of the All-Star Coaches. You have agreed to follow all the rules of the Mississippi Association of Coaches, and are expected to keep your word. M.A.C. Board policy states that "should any All-Star Player violate any rule of conduct of the Association, that player will be sent home immediately."

Game Tickets: \$10.00 general admission tickets can be purchased at the gate on game day (players' immediate family only.)

Insurance: The MAC provides secondary accidental medical insurance. Your parents have already signed a form indicating they understand this procedure.

Meals: A meal will be provided for each player and coach following their game.

COVID-19 safety precautions that will be in place on game day:

There will be **only one entrance** into the coliseum and **only one exit** out of the coliseum.

Everyone entering the coliseum will have their temperature checked.

Spectators and coaches will be required to bring and wear masks while inside the coliseum.

Social distancing will be encouraged.

Hand sanitizing stations will be provided.

There **will not** be a concession stand.

The 25% maximum occupancy restriction will be enforced; allowed attendance will be as follows: players' immediate family, high school coaches, college coaches and media.
