SUBJECT: Instructions for All-Star Activities March 10-12, 2021

Please read the following instructions carefully; this should furnish all the information you need to help you follow through on your responsibilities.

REPORTING DATE: Wednesday, March 10, 2021

REPORTING TIME: Coaches and players report by 9:00 a.m.; bus will depart at 9:30 a.m.

REPORT TO: A.E. Wood Coliseum, on the campus of Mississippi College, Clinton, MS
The Coliseum parking lot is located on Hwy 80 between Springridge Road (I-20 Exit 36) & Clinton/Raymond Road (I-20 Exit 35)

WHAT TO BRING: 1. All practice apparel—shorts, socks and shoes. Shorts should be athletic shorts – no cutoffs.

2. Casual shorts, slacks and shirts.

WHAT NOT TO BRING:

M.A.C. rules will not permit male players to wear earrings during any of the All-Star activities. Therefore we advise those of you who wear earrings to leave them at home. Failure to comply with this rule will result in dismissal from the team. Female players cannot wear earrings in practices or the game.

CONDUCT: All players will be under the supervision of the All-Star Coaches. You have agreed to follow all the rules of the Mississippi Association of Coaches, and are expected to keep your word.

M.A.C. Board policy states that "should any All-Star Player violate any rule of conduct of the Association, that player will be sent home immediately."

INSURANCE: The AHSAA provides secondary accidental medical insurance. Your parents have already signed a form indicating they understand this procedure.

GAME TICKETS: The games will be played Friday, March 12, at the Cramton Bowl Multi-Plex in Montgomery, AL. The girls' game will begin at 5:00 p.m.; the boys' game will follow at approximately 7:00 p.m. Digital tickets may be purchased through GoFan; a link will be posted on our website. Admission will be \$10 (additional fees may apply); 5 & under get in free.

The Cramton Bowl Multi-Plex is located at 220 Hall Street, Montgomery, AL 36104.

CHECKING OUT: After the game, be sure to have your post-participation physical screening completed by the *Mississippi Sports Medicine* trainers before leaving Cramton Bowl Multi-Plex. Players will be dismissed after the game to return home with their parents/guardians; bus transportation will not be available. *Please be sure to make arrangements prior to the end of the game.*
