Insurance: The MAC provides secondary accidental medical insurance. Your parents

have already signed a form indicating they understand this procedure.

What to Bring:

1. All practice apparel--shorts, socks and shoes for practice. Shorts should be

athletic shorts - no cutoffs.

2. Casual shorts, slacks, and shirts.

3. Towels, sheets, pillow, and regular toiletry items used at home.

Conduct: All players will be under the supervision of the MAC and the All-Star
