Report To: All-Star players and coaches will report to Riggs-Virden Residence Hall at

Hinds Community College in Raymond. As stated in the Player Selection

guidelines, female players cannot participate if pregnant.

Housing: Girls will be housed in Allen-Dukes Residence Hall, and boys will be

housed in Riggs-Virden. A representative of Hinds will meet you there to assign rooms and give out keys. Be prepared to make a room deposit of \$10 (bring correct change), which will be refunded at check-out time if your room key is returned and your room is in the same condition in

which you found it.

Rules:

M. A. C. rules will not allow male All-Star Players to wear earrings during All-Star activities. Therefore, we advise those of you who may wear earrings, to leave them at home.

Female players may not wear earrings during practice sessions or matches.

You are expected to exhibit proper conduct and your All-Star Coaches will address specific rules with you. They will have the authority to send any team member found breaking those rules home immediately

Check-out:

You will check out of the dorms Thursday morning after breakfast, and report to Parham Bridges Tennis Center at 10:15 a.m. There will be an awards presentation at 11:00 and the tournament will begin at 11:30. Lunch will be provided at 12:30 p.m.

Tournament:

The tournament will be played at Parham Bridges Tennis Center, 5505 Old Canton Rd, Jackson, MS (corner of Old Canton Road and Ridgewood Road in northeast Jackson), beginning at 11:30 a.m. on Thursday, June 11. Tournament will consist of 6 singles and 3 doubles matches.

After the tournament is concluded, and you have had your postparticipation physical screening by the Mississippi Sports Medicine trainers, you will be free to leave with your parents.
