Please read the following instructions carefully; they should furnish all the information you need to help you follow through on your responsibilities.

## **Reporting Dates**

& Times: 1A/2A/3A/4A All-Stars - Friday, March 20, 2026

• Girls' will report at 2 P.M.

• Boys will report at 3 P.M.

5A/6A/7A All-Stars - Saturday, March 21, 2026

• Girls' will report at 11 A.M.

Boys will report at 12 P.M.

**Report To:** All-Stars will report to A.E. Wood Coliseum on the campus of Mississippi

College located on Highway 80 in Clinton, MS.

What to Bring: All practice apparel--shorts, socks and shoes. Shorts should be athletic shorts.

What <u>NOT</u> To

**Bring:** 

M.A.C. rules will not permit players to wear earrings during any of the

All-Star activities. Therefore, we advise those of you who wear earrings to leave

them at home. Failure to comply with this rule will result in dismissal from the

team.

Cars: If you bring a car, you will be required to park it in the parking lot at all times,

and turn the keys in to your All-Star Coach. Any travel necessary will be

provided by the M.A.C.

**Conduct:** All players will be under the supervision of the All-Star Coaches. You have agreed

to follow all the rules of the Mississippi Association of Coaches, and are expected

to keep your word.

M.A.C. Board policy states that "should any All-Star Player violate any rule of

conduct of the Association, that player will be sent home <u>immediately.</u>"

**Physicals:** As stated in the Player Selection guidelines, female players cannot participate if pregnant.

**Game Tickets:** The 1A/2A/3A/4A games will be played Friday, March 20 at A. E. Wood

Coliseum at Mississippi College in Clinton, MS. The 1A/2A/3A/4A girls' game will begin at 5 P.M., followed by the 1A/2A/3A/4A boys' at approximately 6:30

PM.

The 5A/6A/7A games will be played Saturday, March 21 at A. E. Wood Coliseum at Mississippi College in Clinton, MS. The 5A/6A/7A girls' game will begin at 2

P.M., followed by the 5A/6A/7A boys' at approximately 3:30 PM.

General admission tickets can be purchased on game day for \$10.00 each as well as

through GoFan.

**Insurance:** The MAC provides secondary accidental medical insurance. Your parents have

already signed a form indicating they understand this procedure.

Meals: All meals will be provided.

**Uniforms:** All-Stars will have the option to purchase their game uniform for \$75. Cash or

CashApp will be accepted.

**Checking Out:** Before leaving Mississippi College after the game, be sure to have your post-

participation physical screening by the *Mississippi Sports Medicine* trainers.
